- WESTERN TEAMS MUST HAVE AT LEAST ONE WESTERN RIDER
- JUNIOR TEAMS MUST HAVE AT LEAST ONE JUNIOR RIDER
- WILL BE HELD RAIN OR SHINE
- WILL HAVE GO-ROUNDS AT ALL FENCES
- WILL AWARD RIBBONS 1ST – 10TH PLACE IN EACH DIVISION. RIDERS ACCUMULATE POINTS TOWARDS SERIES AWARDS.
